Jupiter Dance & Performing Arts (JDPA)

JDPA is committed to ensuring that all students, staff, parents/carers, and visitors have equal access to our facilities, classes, and online services. We aim to provide an inclusive environment where everyone can participate fully, regardless of disability, learning need, or access requirements.

Website Accessibility

- JDPA's website is designed in accordance with WCAG 2.1 AA guidelines to support accessibility for users with disabilities.

Physical Environment Accessibility

JDPA is committed to making our classes, events, and facilities as accessible as possible:

- Venues: Ramps, wide doorways, and accessible rooms will be used where available.
- Classrooms/Studios: Floors cleared of hazards, good lighting, and safe spacing for movement.
- Activities: All physical classes include warm-ups, cool-downs, and adaptations for different abilities.
- Equipment: Props, mats, and other resources are safe, maintained, and adjustable where possible.
- Support: Staff are trained to assist students with specific needs and ensure safety.
- Transportation & Arrival: Accessible parking and drop-off points will be indicated where possible.

Communication & Support

- Staff and students can request information in alternative formats (large print, audio, visual cues).
- Parents/carers or students with additional access needs are encouraged to contact staff in advance to ensure appropriate support.
